Round Robin Master

The Round Robin is a warm-up session which gives each person present at the meeting an opportunity to introduce himself/ herself, (e.g. Justin, Boroondara Toastmasters) and then proceed with his/ her contribution which SHOULD BE LIMITED TO ONE OR TWO BRIEF SENTENCES. No more than say 30 seconds! (Otherwise buzzer is activated!)

If Possible, try to link the "Round Robin Master" to the "Theme of the Meeting". If the Theme is say "Easter", perhaps link the question to this topic.

Example: Everyone to answer this question:

Introduce yourself and then make few comments on what you plan to do for Easter. Or what does Easter mean to you? Etc

The Round Robin response SHOULD NOT develop into a "mini speech". The TOTAL time for ALL participants at the meeting to speak in the Round Robin segment is approximately FIVE MINUTES.
